Tractor Pull

Yes, it is true! The Heritage Tractor Adventure will sponsor a tractor pull, put on by the Illini State Pullers, during the Sunday's festivities at the Grundy County Fairgrounds. Also planned that day is a dinner and Max and Orion's "Noon at Night" Show. On the back of this page is a list of the tractor pull rules.

Fee for entering a tractor in the pull is \$20 which will include two admission passes. This is a non-sanctioned pull. We have added a 3500lb class for anyone who wants to pull their tractor and is not heavy enough for the other classes. There will be prize money given in each class. The classes are as follows:

- 3500 lb Stock Tractors (Non-sanctioned)
- 6000 lb Stock Tractors (Non-sanctioned)
- 9000 lb. Stock Tractors (Non-Sanctioned)
- 14000 lb Turbo Stock Tractors (Non-Sanctioned)
- 6500 lb Outlaw Tractors (Non-sanctioned)

Admission to watch the tractor pull is \$5. You can pay now or purchase at the gate. Dinner tickets are \$13 each and should be purchased in advance. If you have purchased the meal wristband which includes all of the meals, it will also allow you entrance to view the pull. Max and Orion's show is free!

So come early and stay the day. There will be food, tractors, noise, Max, Orion. Who could ask for more??!

2011 American Heritage Tractor Pull

Sunday June 12 1:00 PM

Grundy County Fair Grounds

1. All Tractors must be weighted at the fairgrounds and ready to pull at 12:30PM. Entries accepted up to this time.
2. Contest open to all rubber tired tractors, with each tractor limited to 2 classes. No four wheel drive or duals allowed. Stock block only.
3. Minimum drawbar length is 18" from center of rear axle. Drawbar height is 20" maximum from ground. No pulling from 2 or 3 point hitches.
4. All weights must be safely secured to tractor and must not extend 14" beyond front wheels, rear weights must not extend behind rear wheels.
5. The use of torque converters, auto shifts, etc. are permitted during the pull.
6. All pulls must start from a tight hitch. No jerking permitted.
7. Only 1 hook per vehicle per class, unless a tie is declared.
8. The pull is considered over when forward progress stops. No hole digging.
9. Vehicles must stop immediately upon signal from judges.
10. All common rules of safety must be followed.
11. All entries must be on official entry blank and completed in full.
12. No nitro fuels in any lots.
13. No weight changing on track during pulls.
14. No one allowed on track during pull.
15. 2000 RPM limit on Natural Aspirated classes. 2800 RPM limit on turbo classes. Compliance will be verified immediately following pull, prior to contestant returning to pits.
16. Track official has final ruling.
17. No sanctioned vehicles allowed.
18. All drivers must be 16 years old or older.
19. No cut tires allowed.
